

**Clients' Profiles Fact Sheet
Seniors Served by SSA**



Orange County has a population of 508,783 seniors age 65 and older*. The population increased by 11.3% from Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-17 to FY 2019-20, and a further increase of 11.5% is projected from FY 2019-20 to FY 2022-23. SSA provided one or more types of services and assistance to approximately 1 out of every 6 senior residents of the County in June 2020.
