Adults Served by SSA**



Orange County has a population of 1,766,779 adults between the ages of 18 and 59*. The population decreased by 1.9% from Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-19 to FY 2021-22, and a further decrease of 1.2% is projected from FY 2021-22 to FY 2024-25. SSA provided one or more types of services and assistance to approximately 1 out of every 3 adult residents of the County in June 2022.
