

**Clients' Profiles Fact Sheet
Seniors Served by SSA**



Orange County has a population of 746,976 seniors age 60 and older*. The population increased by 10.2% from Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-19 to FY 2021-22, and a further increase of 9.2% is projected from FY 2021-22 to FY 2024-25. SSA provided one or more types of services and assistance to approximately 1 out of every 4 senior residents of the County in June 2022.
