Orange County has a population of 688,469 children under the age of 18*. The population decreased by 2.9% from Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-20 to FY 2022-23, and a further decrease of 2.9% is projected from FY 2022-23 to FY 2025-26. SSA provided one or more types of services and assistance to approximately 1 out of every 2 child residents of the County in June 2023.
