

# GIVE THEM A CHANCE...

A hospital emergency room, fire station with Safely Surrendered Baby logo or Orangewood Children's Home will take your newborn baby (up to 3 days old). You will not be identified or prosecuted. Don't throw your baby away!

... A CHANCE FOR LIFE!

### A message from the Social Services Agency

Child welfare workers will place your baby in a licensed foster home while finding the best adoptive family. You can change your mind within 14 days. A new law lets anyone with legal custody of a newborn baby (up to 3 days old) give the baby to a hospital emergency room, fire station with Safely Surrendered Baby logo or Orangewood Children's Home staff, without identification or police involvement.

Don't throw your baby away.

Give them a chance for life!

## Locations where you can take your newborn baby include:

- Any hospital emergency room, or
- Fire stations displaying the Safely Surrendered Baby logo.

### What will happen at the hospital?

Newborn babies up to three days old will be taken care of, given medical treatment and placed in a safe home. It is strictly confidential. You will know that your baby has been taken care of.
